THIS WEEK

WED 8: BLESSED JOHN SULLIVAN, was baptised in the Church of Ireland in 1861. Studied Law and Classics and was received into the Catholic Church aged 35. Became a Jesuit and was ordained in 1907, spending his life at Clongowes. Had a reputation as a person of prayer, always available to the sick. Beatified in 2017, the first-ever beatification in Ireland.

• Today is a time of 'Remembrance and Reconciliation' for those who died in WWII (UN).

THURS 9: 'ASCENSION THURSDAY', the 40th day after Easter Sunday. The Ascension of the Lord is celebrated next Sunday, 12 May.

FRI 10: ST COMGHALL, native of Co Antrim, studied under Finnian of Moville, established a monastery at Bangor which attracted people like St Columbanus. Also founded a monastery at Tiree in Scotland. Died AD 638.

OUR LADY WILL HAVE NO REST TILL JUDGEMENT DAY



When speaking about the Blessed Virgin Mary, St John Vianney said: 'Only after the last judgment will Mary get any rest; from now until then, she is much too busy with her children'.

If there is one thing many of the great saints have in common, it is this: all of them had a deep love for Our Lady and they understood the great love that God has for his most holy mother.
