400th Anniversary of the Basilica of St. Peter (1626-2026)

While the Co-Cathedral Parish in Skibbereen marks her bicentenary this year, another Church is marking her fourth-centenary in 2026. Cardinal Mauro Gambetti, this week announced initiatives for the 400th anniversary of the Basilica's dedication, including a multilingual platform for pilgrims, access to previously inaccessible areas, and the launch of the new 'Michelangelus' font.

The year begins on 20th February with the inauguration of a new *Way of the Cross* and will conclude on 18th November with Mass presided over by Pope Leo XIV.

Describing a year of spiritual, cultural, and technological developments, Cardinal Gambetti revealed new services for pilgrims and visitors. He anticipated a multilingual liturgical platform developed with the Dicastery for Communication and *Translated*, a global leader in AI-based language solutions. Translations will be accessible by smartphone, enabling the faithful to follow the principal celebrations in their chosen language.
