#### Feasts this week

**20<sup>th</sup>: St Fachaean.** Although little is known with certainty about Fachanan, a strong tradition from early times links him with Kilfenora and records that he founded a church or monastery there in the sixth century. He is venerated as the patron of the diocese of Kilfenora, now part of Galway.

21<sup>st</sup>: St Peter Canisius, 1521-97, was born in Holland. He intended to become a lawyer but joined the Jesuits. Through courtesy and learning he promoted the Catholic revival after the Council of Trent. His greatest work was a catechism of 211 questions and answers, published in 1555

23<sup>rd</sup>: St John of Kanty, 1390-1473, taught theology and Scripture in the university of Krakow, Poland. He is remembered for his austerity of life and generosity. 27<sup>th</sup>: St John, brother of James, son of Zebedee, the disciple whom Jesus loved, is traditionally said to have died in Ephesus. He is considered to be the author of the Fourth Gospel, the Book of Revelation and three Letters. The Letters especially teach us the law of love; John is said in his old age to have preached only one message: love one another.


#### **Parishes Funeral Team**
