WHY GO TO CONFESSION?

J ger of divine mercy. He called sinners to repentance, that is, to turn away from sin and to turn towards God. The first stage in the journey of repentance is our awareness of sin, our recognition of having done something wrong. Our conscience is the arbiter enabling us to do this.

The next step is confession, which has deed a wonderful sacrament. always been highly esteemed in our tradition. Living up to the moral and religious ideals of Christianity cannot be achieved in a day. We need to set out on the journey again and again.

The next step is to "do penance", that is, to perform some action that costs us an effort, like alms-giving, or fasting, or a religious action, something that gives expression to our desire to make amends and turn over a new leaf. Grace does not negate our part in the story, but rather enables us to do what in us lies in order to avoid sin.

The final step in the journey is the Word
