WED 25: BLESSED THADDEUS McCARTHY died at the age of 37 in Ivrea in Italy. A native of West Cork, he is honoured in Caheragh in the name of the parish GAA Club (Tadhg MacCárthaigh). A victim of church politics, his appointment to the Cork, Cloyne and Ross dioceses in Co Cork was contested locally but upheld by the pope. He died on his way home from Rome, and was honoured by the local bishop in Ivrea. Beatified in 1896. Blessed Thaddeus, 'one of our own' in heaven, pray for us!



IS YOUR HEART

ON FIRE WITH GOD?

Two disciples were on their way to Emmaus, heartbroken. The death on a cross of their friend Jesus shattered their hopes and dreams. As they walked along, Jesus walked beside them. They did not recognise him, because He had been transformed. They told him the reason for their

sadness, so Jesus 'explained what was said in the Scriptures concerning himself' (Lk.24:27). Remembering this later, they mused: 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us?'

The disciples invited the stranger to eat with them. Their 'eyes were opened and they recognised Him' but he had vanished from their sight. Pope Francis tells us that in this we can recognise an essential reality of our faith.

Christ, who breaks the bread, now becomes bread broken, shared and consumed. He is seen no longer, for now he

has entered the hearts of the disciples to make them burn all the more.

Through our Baptism we are called to become like Jesus. It is our Mission to share the joy of the Gospel. How do we do this? We 'set out to make other hearts burn with the Word of God, to open the

eyes of others to Jesus in the Eucharist, and invite everyone to walk together on the path of peace', said Pope Francis.

The theme chosen by the pope this year is inspired by the story of the disciples going to Emmaus: 'Hearts on fire, feet on the move'.

On Mission Sunday we join Pope Francis in supporting missions around the world. Through this support we can become the spark

that transforms lives!
