

Our child feels safe in this country, she often tells us that she really likes school and her teacher. Yeva remembers her home in Ukraine as cosy and safe. She asks when we will return but we don't have an answer to this question. She does not know that it is not safe there now, as there are a lot of weapons in the country and missiles continue to fly over our house.

On Christmas Eve we would like to wish peace in the whole world, for all families to be reunited, that people are happy and healthy. Remember that today will not be repeated. Enjoy every day.
