HOLY SAT 30: The tradition of blessing the food consumed on Easter is a Polish/Slavic custom that dates back to medieval times. The Christian community ask God's blessing on the foods that will break the Great Fast (Lent) from which they have abstained for 40 days.

- DAY 35, HOLY MONDAY: Write an overdue card, or a letter, or a text.
- DAY 36, HOLY TUESDAY: Gather your donation for *Trócaire* and send it off.
- DAY 37, SPY WEDNESDAY: Pray for someone whose forgiveness you need.
- DAY 38, HOLY THURSDAY: An act of kindness honours Jesus, who washed feet.
- DAY 39, GOOD FRIDAY: Fast from food and abstain from meat; keep an hour's silence.
- DAY 40, HOLY SATURDAY: Keep your lenten promises till the Easter Vigil tonight. Then enjoy Easter and its fifty days of feasting!
