READY TO BE TRANSFORMED? THEN RECEIVE COMMUNION ...

his Sunday we celebrate Corpus Christi, in times past celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. Today we give thanks for the Eucharist — we ponder this great gift given to us on Holy Thursday. In today's gospel reading, we hear that the blood of Jesus was to be poured out for many. In giving his body and blood, Jesus made our covenant with God anew.

HOW TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION

If you are right handed, the left hand should rest on the right. The host is laid in the palm of the left hand and taken by the right hand to the mouth. [If you are left-handed, this is reversed.] The person distributing Communion says audibly, 'The Body of Christ'. Communicants audibly respond 'Amen', indicating their belief that this small wafer of bread is the body and blood of Christ the Lord.
