This doesn't just happen abroad. Patrick Kavanagh's poem 'Epic' describes a local row:

I heard the Duffys shouting 'Damn your soul!'

And old McCabe stripped to the waist, seen

Step the plot defying blue cast-steel ...

Wherever love is lacking, people suffer. When I am the cause, I am the sinner. I need forgiveness — and the grace to make a new start. Fortunately, God gently lavishes both, without measure.

I am leading a service of reconciliation on the Monday of Holy Week (that's 14 April). It's at 7 pm in the Cathedral, Skibbereen. Several priests will be there to bring God's forgiveness - to you and me.

Come and see. We can begin again, for Easter.
