LEO: WHAT WE KNOW SO FAR

The former Bob Prevost was born on Chicago's south side — the poorer and more Catholic side of the city, where many

Irish people also settled. The south side of Chicago also has many troubled neighbourhoods, with drug problems, poverty and violence. Bob learned a lot about life in Chicago, Illinois.

Fr Bob Prevost OSA worked in Trujillo, Peru, as a missionary, close to where our Cork & Ross priests worked. Many of our missionaries knew him. He has their respect.

Cardinal Bob Prevost chose Leo as his papal name when elected on 7 May. The last Pope Leo wrote a major defence of workers' rights, called 'Rerum Novarum'. Our new pope sees how easily workers can be exploited today in the "gig" economy. He wants a church on the side of the poor, migrants, the dispossessed.

> The first Leo may also inspire him. The story goes that Pope Leo I was bishop of Rome when Attila the Hun was about to attack the city. This kindly man went out to meet Attila, unarmed and alone, and per-

suaded him to leave the Romans in peace; this won their bishop (and pope) the title Leo the Great

The people of Rome loved St Leo and admired his courage. May our Pope Leo have the same gift of courage, to speak against all who oppose Christian and human values.
