# PRIESTS SHOULD ABSOLVE ALL GRAVE SINS — EVEN ABORTION

fter the Jubilee Year of Mercy in 2016, Pope Francis wrote a letter called *Misericordia et misera* ('Mercy and Misery'). This letter charts a path forward for our church, rooted in care and compassion. Francis wanted a shift of emphasis away from condemnation and guilt.

Drawing inspiration from the Gospel account of the woman caught in adultery (John 8: 1-11), the pope highlighted the encounter between human frailty and mercy. *Misericordia* (MERCY) is Christ himself; *misera* (MISERY) is the sinner. Judgment gives



way to forgiveness, and condemnation to hope. The sin is acknowledged but the sinner pardoned. *Misericordia et Misera* calls for mercy and forgiveness as essentials of church life—as a permanent mission. Pope Francis asks all priests to absolve grave sins, including abortion: no barrier should stand between the sinner and God's forgiveness (cf. Romans 8:35).

Francis also encouraged us to continue works of mercy, as expressions of love in our ordinary lives. We are to be 'artisans of mercy', transforming our parishes and our hearts into places of welcome and healing. Mercy is the Church's most powerful message in a world of greed and anger.
