

WHY IS THE POPE GOING TO TURKEY?

pope Leo will fly to Turkey and Lebanon later this week, his first overseas trip. International travel to meet, evangelise and affirm the faithful is now on every pope's list of duties.

On Friday Pope Leo will take a helicopter ride from Istanbul to Iznik, a lakeside town with a long history (previously known as Nicaea). He'll pray with the Patriarch of Constantinople, near the site of the first Council of Nicaea in AD 325 — 1,700 years since Constantine gathered 300 bishops together to agree on a formal statement of our faith — what it means to be a Christian.
